Investment Objective

The Fund's investment philosophy is shaped by the belief that active management must fully integrate constructive engagement across the portfolio to unlock and drive greater recognition of fundamental value, which is of particular importance in Emerging Markets.

The fund seeks to invest via a proprietary and tested two-pillar process that aims to identify undervalued businesses through its fundamentally-driven bottom up approach, alongside partnering with all portfolio companies with an aim to generate alpha from material ESG and operational improvements. This is reflected in a high-conviction, concentrated core strategy with a long-term focus on harnessing the power of compounding cashflows and active ESG engagement.

The Fund's investment objective is to achieve capital growth and is actively managed by reference to and seeks to outperform the MSCI Emerging Markets Net Total Return Index. The Fund is mainly exposed to the issuers of the benchmark, however, the management of the Fund is discretionary, and will be exposed to issuers not included in the benchmark. The Fund monitors risk exposure in relation to the benchmark however the extent of deviation from the benchmark is expected to be material.
